Blood Donor Ambassador

Position Overview:

By providing excellent and enthusiastic customer service to enhance the blood donor experience, volunteers encourage returning blood donations.

Responsibilities:

- Welcoming and greeting donors
- Confirming donation appointments
- Checking-in donors and going through necessary information pamphlets
- Monitoring the status of donors and direct flow of waiting donors
- Thanking them for their life-saving donation

Resume Key Phrases

- "Provided efficient administrative support through patient appointment portal, answering patient inquiries, and monitoring donation center operations"
- "Created a welcoming environment for incoming patients as well as established a positive exit impression for completed donors"

Blood Services Transportation Specialist

Position Overview:

Transporting blood and blood products to their designated location in a safe and timely manner

Responsibilities:

- Distributing blood and blood products to hospitals in area for routine or "STAT" deliveries
- Transporting collections from blood donation sites to the laboratory to be processed
- Picking up and returning boxes or equipment as needed

Resume Key Phrases

- "Oversaw the packaging and transportation of vital blood product materials on an efficient, routine schedule"

Blood Services Scheduling Team Member

Position Overview:

Supporting the scheduling of Blood Donor Ambassador teams is crucial to ensure a full coverage of donation shifts.

Responsibilities:

- Managing the scheduling of blood drives for specified county location
- Communicating regularly with Biomedical Services volunteers to fill Blood Drive Ambassador shifts

Resume Key Phrases

- "Scheduled and organized X number of regional blood donation events"
- "**Ensured** staff shift requirements were met through consistent team communication"

DAT Team Member: Client-Facing

Position Overview:

Providing 24-hr emergency response to local disasters to ensure that victims have basic necessities like shelter, clothing, and food

Responsibilities:

- Ensuring families affected by disaster have their immediate needs met
- Conducting intake interviews
- Providing compassion and hope for victims in the situation

Disaster Health Services Team Member

Position Overview:

Providing hands-on care, education, and health assessment during an emergency response to local or large-scale disasters, primarily in a shelter environment or virtual care.

Responsibilities:

- Assisting shelter clients with hands-on health care and functional needs
- Providing education and health assessments
- Assisting clients in replacing medications, medical equipment, and related supplies

- "Maintained a safe and clean disaster recovery environment for affected community members"
- "Assisted in administering health assessments"
- "Documented patient information through the use of patient log program"
- "Provided direct support for patients through medication administering and scheduling of inventory shipments"

Disaster Mental Health Services Team Member

Position Overview:

Providing mental health services and education during disaster preparedness, response, and recovery within local chapter

Responsibilities:

- Providing Disaster Mental Health interventions to clients impacted by disasters
- Participating in relevant meetings, activities, and events as a team member
- Supporting other disaster responders before, during, and after a disaster response situation using designated staff mental health strategies

Home Fire Campaign Team Member

Position Overview:

Saving lives and preventing injury through preparedness trainings

Responsibilities:

- Providing residents with free smoke alarm installation
- Leading fire safety education programs
- Conducting neighborhood canvassing
- Facilitating planning events for fire safety programming

Position Overview:

Providing emergency preparedness education programming to youth audiences in elementary school classrooms and other relevant settings

Responsibilities:

- Conducting The Pillowcase Project presentations to young audience
- Working as a team to enhance The Pillowcase Project within the region
- Ensuring all reporting data for each presentation given is collected and presented to regional staff in a timely manner

Resume Key Phrases

- "Facilitated a safe and informative learning environment for young audiences on the importance of fire safety through simulation training, education about fire alarms, evacuation plans, and more"

Recovery Team Member

Position Overview:

Supporting the disaster recovery of individuals, families, and communities through activities of casework, recovery planning, recovery systems, and community recovery projects

Responsibilities:

- Conducting client interviews
- Assessing client qualifications for direct client assistance sessions
- Using the Client Assistance System (CAS) 2.0 to document the assistance and services provided to the client

Disaster Response - Logistics Team Member

Position Overview:

Supporting logistical operations with Disaster Services during preparedness, response, and recovery within a region, ensuring that required supplies, equipment, and materials are ready

Responsibilities:

- Ordering and storing of supplies, warehousing, and local procurement
- Inspecting facilities, stocking materials, and strategically staging resources to be accessed
- Coordinating the distribution of materials needed

Disaster Workforce Engagement Team Member

Position Overview:

Supporting the onboarding, training, engagement, development and/or recognition of the Disaster Services volunteer workforce

Responsibilities:

- Assisting with various aspects of workforce engagement
- Communicating regularly with volunteers and support staff
- Documenting activities and information within the volunteer data management systems

Resume Key Phrases

Hero Care Critical Community Services Caseworker

Position Overview:

Providing military members' families and veterans with casework services, family follow-ups, information, resources, and referrals to organizations for continued assistance

Responsibilities:

- Ensuring regional capacity to provide follow up and region referral to military clients
- Assuring that the team maintains strict confidentiality of any personal information gathered
- Managing administration tasks in relation to staff access to the SAF Case Management System

Medical Treatment Facilities (MTF) General Volunteers

Position Overview:

Providing assistance with tasks in a clinical setting, supporting staff in a variety of direct or indirect patient care activities, as well as enhance patient morale

Responsibilities:

- Completing administrative tasks such as answering phones, filing materials, data entry
- Providing comfort care items, craft assistance, chair/bedside assistance
- Completing clinic duties such as acting as a runner, receptionist, and preparing patient rooms for treatment

Resume Key Phrases

- "Proficient in data entry software for organizing client information, analyzing inventory status, as well as connecting patient case needs with respective departments"
- "Prepared patient rooms in accordance with treatment specifications to assist medical staff with efficiency"
- "Transported supplies to directed departments in a timely manner"

Medical Treatment Facilities (MTF) Licensed Professionals

Position Overview:

Providing assistance with specific services or treatments designated for clients in urgent care, outpatient/inpatient settings, or other related healthcare units based on credentialed qualifications

Responsibilities:

- Preforming patient care duties within licensing abilities, training, credentials
- Greeting and screening patients, taking vital measurements, transporting specimens, dispensing needed medications, preforming diagnostic tests such as venipunctures and IVs

Resume Key Phrases

- "Administered necessary medications and diagnostic exams to collect samples for laboratory analysis"
- "Cultivated a welcoming environment for patients during the health assessment exam and answered any questions in an accessible health literacy manner"
- "Collaborated with cross-department teams to access additional treatment options if not currently available"

Volunteer Screener

Position Overview:

Gathering relevant information about prospective volunteer candidates while assessing which positions the volunteer may be suitable for

Responsibilities:

- Scheduling and conducting volunteer screenings over the phone with prospective volunteers
- Studying each volunteer position description
- Preparing for each screening interview by reading candidate application questionnaires
- Matching volunteers to positions for which they are best suited based on specific skills

Resume Key Phrases

Volunteer Recruiter

Position Overview:

Using a variety of activities to build a diverse and talented volunteer workforce

Responsibilities:

- Studying volunteer position descriptions and high priority positions for the region
- Utilizing social media platforms for digital recruitment, networking with other organizations, and creating events to gather interest for high priority volunteer positions
- Creating flyers, other physical pieces of recruitment materials to increase interest in Red Cross volunteering

Resume Key Phrases

- "Identified and networked with potential partner accounts on popular social media platforms for future collaboration events for new health education programming"
- "Combined high-priority volunteer position needs with incentive products that provided an increase in volunteer applications"

Red Cross Club Coordinator

Position Overview:

Serving as a liaison between regional Red Cross Youth Program and individual Red Cross Club leadership members for high school and collegelevel students

Responsibilities:

- Assisting leadership with ensuring that club members complete the Red Cross application and consistently log volunteer hours
- Connecting club leadership with Red Cross resources to support individual service projects

- "Fostered a welcoming and encouraging environment for the local high school's Red Cross Club by assigning group leads for upcoming mission-based projects"
- "Provided members with several tools to increase understanding of how to navigate the Volunteer Connect website for vital processes such as logging hours"
